Training/Schooling Rules/Health & Safety Conditions:

1. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any applicant or amend the content of the schooling session.
2. SUFFOLK RIDING CLUB shall not be liable for any claim in respect of damage, loss, injury or accident to any person, horse or property howsoever caused in connection with or arising out of schooling event. It shall be deemed a condition of riding that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the Suffolk Riding Club or any person acting on their behalf against any legal action arising from such an incident.
3. When mounted, riders **MUST** wear protective headgear which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points & securely fastened. Hats to be marked: British - PAS 015:1998 or 2011 / BSEN1384:1997 or 2012, provided they are BSI Kitemarked. European - EN1384:1996 provided they are BSI Kitemarked. American - All SEI, ASTM F1163:2004a. or 04a, SNELL E2001. Australian & New Zealand - All SAI AS/NZS 3838:2006OR SEI. Hair must not hang longer than the shoulder line.
4. Riders are advised to wear body protectors at all times when mounted and body protectors are compulsory when schooling over Cross Country Jumps. Gloves are also strongly recommended.
5. All horses / ponies must be 4 years old or over to take part in the schooling session.
6. Any horse / pony which might kick, or is known to kick, MUST wear a Red Ribbon on its tail.
7. Emergency services must have access to ALL AREAS of the Schooling Venue at all times. DO NOT OBSTRUCT ACCESS.
8. Stirrups must be "run up" or "crossed over" the saddle when the rider is not mounted.
9. No person shall bring a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to the schooling session without taking adequate precautions to ensure that other riders and members of the public are not put at risk of injury. Stallions may not be ridden or led by children 14 years and under.
10. Spurs are not allowed without the permission of the Instructor.
11. SRC Dress code applies. Reminder: Hair must not hang longer than the shoulder line. If not secured in a hair net, hair must be tied up accordingly.
