This will include, but is not limited to:

- No events to be organised without the knowledge and approval of the committee.
- Risk assessments to cover the activity and location.
- First aid or medical cover, in line with British Riding Clubs policy
- Suffolk Riding Club Safeguarding policy and procedures
- Suffolk Riding Club Dress Code
- COVID Risk assessment and mitigation procedures.
- Instructors to be registered on the British Horse Society Register of Approved Instructors.
- Coaches to hold accredited professional qualifications.
